An Act to amend the Firearms Act, R.S.A. c. F30.

ENACTED by the Legislature of Anguilla

Interpretation

1. In this Act, “principal Act” means the Firearms Act, R.S.A. c. F30.

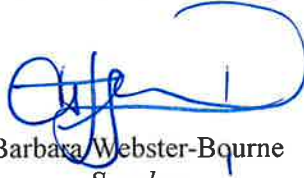
Amendment to section 1

2. Section 1 of the principal Act is amended by deleting the definition of “restricted weapon” and substituting it with the following—

““restricted weapon” means any weapon of whatever description or design which is adapted for the discharge of electricity, any noxious liquid, gas or other thing;”.
