

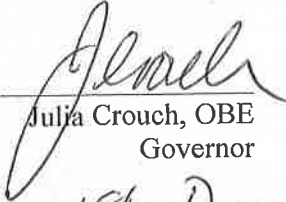

ALLOWANCES (TEMPORARY) REDUCTION (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2024

[Gazette Date: 18th December, 2024] [Commencement: Section 3]

An Act to amend the Allowances (Temporary) Reduction Act, 2023 (Act No. 25/2023).

ENACTED by the Legislature of Anguilla

Interpretation

1. In this Act the “principal Act” means the Allowances (Temporary) Reduction Act, 2023 (Act No. 25/2023).

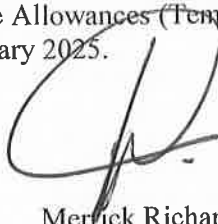
Amendment of section 8

2. The principal Act is amended in section 8 by deleting subsection (2) and substituting it with the following—

“(2) Notwithstanding the repeal of the Public Service Salaries (Temporary) Reduction Act, 2013 (Act No. 2/2013) the annual payment of increments is suspended for the 2024 and 2025 Financial years.”.

Citation and commencement

3. This Act may be cited as the Allowances (Temporary) Reduction (Amendment) Act, 2024 and shall come into force on 1 January 2025.

OBJECTS AND REASONS

(The Objects and Reasons do not form part of this Bill)

The amendment to the Allowances (Temporary) Reduction Act, 2023 (Act No. 25/2023) extends the suspension of the annual payment of increments into the 2025 Financial year. The Government is currently undertaking a public sector compensation review and until such review is completed, any annual pay increments will remain suspended.
