FIREARMS ACT, R.S.A. C. F30

FIREARMS (AMNESTY ORDER) REGULATIONS, 2024

Regulations made by the Governor under sections 48 and 51 of the Firearms Act, R.S.A. C. F30.

Amnesty Order

1. Any person who is in possession of any firearm and ammunition or both and is not the holder of a licence issued under the Firearms Act in respect of such firearm or ammunition or both, shall not be liable to be prosecuted for the contravention of the provisions of the Firearms Act by reason only of his possession of such firearm or ammunition or both, if he surrenders such firearm or ammunition or both, to the police officer in charge at the Valley police station in Anguilla during the amnesty period specified in section 2.

Amnesty period

2. The amnesty period begins at midnight on Sunday 28 January, 2024 and ends at midnight on 11 February, 2024.

Applicability of section 8 of the Firearms Regulations, R.R.A. F30-3

3. Section 8 of the Firearms Regulations, R.R.A. F30-3 shall not apply during the period of amnesty.

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Firearms (Amnesty Order) Regulations, 2024.
