- ◆ A strong background in teaching, research, publications, and higher education administration.
- ◆ Skills in educational planning, curriculum development, and modern teaching methods.

Applicants should hold at least a **Master's degree** with significant progressive leadership experience in tertiary education, or a **Doctoral degree** with senior academic and administrative experience. Evidence of scholarly publications, successful grant funding, and contributions to accreditation, policy development, and college administration is required.
