## DECLARATION OF KINGSTOWN

RECALLING the historic ties which exist between the peoples of Africa and the Caribbean and; Recognizing the important role played by the Leader Muammar Al Gaddafi, Chairman of the African Union in connecting Latin America, the Caribbean and Africa as the way to strengthen partnership and promote South-South Corporation;

DETERMINED to follow up on the Meeting that was held in Tripoli 28-30 August, 2001 between the Great Socialist People's Libyan Arab Jamahiriya and Leaders of Eastern Caribbean States, that laid the foundation for multi-faceted relations between the two sides;
