2022 North Atlantic Hurricane Season- Be Prepared, Be Safe! Notice to: all vessel owners, masters and seafarers.

The Anguilla Maritime Administration and Shipping Registry would like to encourage all vessel owners, masters and seafarers to:

- 1. Listen to the local radio stations for marine weather updates before venturing out to sea.
- 2. Be attentive to all weather updates and notices issued by the Department of Disaster Management via Facebook: **Department of Disaster Management Anguilla**, and local radio stations when a storm is approaching.
- 3. Take all precautionary measures to ensure that you are safe and your vessel is secured.
- 4. Use credible sources for weather information and updates.
- 5. Confirm weather updates posted or shared by individuals on social media, from a credible source.

For your safety and the protection of your vessel(s), kindly put these actions into practice as the peak of the 2022 North Atlantic Hurricane Season approaches.
