

PRESS RELEASE CONSULTANCY

The Government of Anguilla (GoA) has requested assistance from the Caribbean Disaster Risk Financing Technical Assistance (DRFTA) Program administered by the World Bank Group, and financed by the European Union.

The GoA is seeking to improve their capability to assess the social and financial impacts of disasters. The integration of information systems would allow the production of a statistical database necessary for quantification of disaster damage and loss. It would also facilitate a dynamic response by the GoA to the need for data and to make evidence-based decisions in a timely manner.

The World Bank Group is seeking the services of a qualified consultant to undertake the task of a **Data Systems Consultant in Anguilla**. The main objective of this assignment is to investigate the feasibility of integrating key systems within the GoA, compile an inventory of data and associated systems and begin the process which will be used to generate statistics quantifying post-disaster damages, losses and financial expenditures.

The consultant will work in collaboration with the World Bank Task Team for this assignment as well as the Government of Anguilla's Statistics Department.

The duration of the consultancy is 60 working days and is expected to start in October 2020

The closing date for applications is August 3, 2020.
