PUBLIC HEALTH ACT, R.S.A. C. P125

PUBLIC HEALTH (COVID-19 REGULATION OF PORTS) (AMENDMENT) (NO. 5) REGULATIONS, 2021

Regulations made by the Minister with approval of Executive Council under section 8 of the Public Health Act, R.S.A. c. P125.

Interpretation

1. In these Regulations, the principal Regulations means Public Health (COVID-19 Regulation of Ports) Regulations, 2020 (R.A. 93/2020).

Amendment of section 1

2. Section 1 of the principal Regulations is amended by deleting the definition of "specified period" and substituting it with the following—

""specified period" means 7 May 2021 to 20 May 2021".

Amendment of section 2

- 3. Section 2 of the principal Regulations is amended by—
 - (a) deleting subsection (1) and substituting it with the following—
 - "(1) The entry or departure by aircraft, ships, vessels, or boats to or from any place in Anguilla is prohibited during the specified period."; and
 - (b) inserting the following new paragraph immediately after paragraph (c)—
 - "(ca) aircrafts, ships, vessels or boats used for the repatriation of—
 - (i) Anguilla citizens sent overseas by the Health Authority of Anguilla or a private health care provider to seek medical treatment, and
 - (ii) any persons who accompanied the citizens referred to in sub-paragraph (i).".

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Health (COVID-19 Regulation of Ports) (Amendment) (No. 5) Regulations, 2021.
