



**HIGHER EDUCATION LICENSING (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2018**

[Gazette Dated: 16<sup>th</sup> July, 2018] [Commencement: Assent under section 57 of the Constitution]

An Act to amend the Higher Education Licensing Act, R.S.A. c. H4.

ENACTED by the Legislature of Anguilla

**Interpretation**

1. In this Act, “principal Act” means the Higher Education Licensing Act, R.S.A. c. H4.


**Amendment to section 26**

2. Section 26 of the principal Act is amended by deleting subsection (2) and substituting it with the following—

“26(2) The Governor in Council may, by regulations, authorise any accreditation body or authority to accredit medical programmes and qualifications or non-medical programmes and qualifications offered by an institution in Anguilla and for the purposes of this Act such accreditation body or authority referred to in subsection (2) shall be recognised by the Board as a foreign accrediting body.”.

3. This Act may be cited as the Higher Education Licensing (Amendment) Act, 2018.

**OBJECT AND REASONS**

*(The objects and reasons do not form part of the Bill)*

The Higher Education Licensing (Amendment) Bill seeks to amend the Higher Education Licensing Act c. H4.

The Bill consists of 3 clauses.

**Clause 1** is the interpretation section of the Bill.

**Clause 2** now provides that the Governor in Council may, by regulation, authorise any accreditation body or authority to accredit medical programmes and qualifications offered by an institution in Anguilla in addition to his existing power to authorise any accreditation body or authority to accredit non-medical programmes and qualifications.

**Clause 3** provides the citation of the Bill.
