This amount was less than the expected cost of the development. - (c) tasked PS, EDICT to come up with two or three scenarios for future airport development against which the current proposal for the location of the Fire Station/Air Traffic Control Tower could be assessed to ensure that the plan was 'future-proofed';
- (d) recognised the urgency and tasked officials to sit down and discuss and advise so that an informed and timely decision could be made.
