Further to EX MIN 16/530 of 1 September 2016, Mr Allen Barnett, Airport Consultant updated Council on the progress of the CJLIA with regard to the safety and security instructions by the Air Safety Support International (ASSI). Mr Barnett pointed out that:-

- (i) there had been changes to the security management set up;
- (ii) a proper quality management system was being put in place. Technical assistance was sought from the BVI for training in this area, which was favourably agreed; and
- (iii) the weather equipment had been resolved.

Mr Fabian M. Fahie, Chairman, AASPA stated that there was need for institutional strengthening going forward, which included human resource development and further technical assistance and training support. Mr Fahie further stated that the matter was not just an immediate need to close findings but an organisational issue.

Council noted that by mid-October 2016, the CJIA should have met the safety and security instructions specified by the Air Safety Support International (ASSI).
