EX MIN 20/238 **COVID-19 REGULATIONS**

Hon Parliamentary Secretary and Ministerial Assistant to the Hon Minister, MHA, remained. PS, Health, Lands & Physical Planning, Mr Foster Rogers and Commissioner of Police, Mr Paul Morrison joined.

Further to EX MIN 20/232 of 21 May, Council:

- (i) confirmed that the Public Health (Temporary Restrictions on Movement of People and Public Gatherings) Regulations, 2020 should not be extended after Sunday 31 May 2020;

- (ii) agreed that the Emergency Powers (Border Security and Control) Regulations which remains in force until Sunday 31 May 2020 should be renewed effective Monday 1 June 2020. Further agreed that:
 - (a) fishers were allowed to go fishing on any day provided their vessel is equipped with a GPS tracking device; and
 - (b) fishing is prohibited on the southern side of Anguilla unless by exemption.
- (iii) agreed that the Attorney General’s Chambers should amend the Temporary Closure of Ports Regulations to allow anyone to leave the island including local carriers and for government approved “repatriation” flights/vessels returning people to Anguilla.

 1. Anguillian status holders/belongers
 2. permanent residents/resident status
 3. valid work permit holders
 4. other (agreed to an internal exercise working out descriptive categories)
- (iii) agreed that initial priority be given to belonger students;
- (iv) agreed that a public message on this process should be sent out by Wednesday 27 May (Hon Deputy Governor to co-ordinate on the message to be sent out); and

- (v) agreed that user friendly versions of the document above should be made available for the community.
