Council:

- agreed that duty and tax exemptions should be granted to Mr Patrick Webster on the importation of items to repair his fishing boat;
- 2) agreed that the administrative fee under the Customs Administrative Cost Recovery Act should apply;

- 3) noted that the estimated duty and tax loss to the Government is EC\$2,418.84 minus 5% which represents the customs administration fees which are payable;
- 4) noted that the Ministry of Finance in collaboration with the Department of Youth and Culture have previously identified EC\$593,795 in expenditure savings from the cancellation of the Anguilla Summer Festival, which had an allocation of EC\$890K; and
