An Act to amend the House of Assembly (Powers and Privileges) Act, R.S.A. c. H15.

ENACTED by the Legislature of Anguilla

Interpretation

1. In this Act—

"principal Act" means the House of Assembly (Powers and Privileges) Act, R.S.A. c. H15.

General amendment

2. The principal Act is amended by deleting the word "stranger" wherever it occurs and substituting it with the word "non-member".

Amendment of section 1

3. The principal Act is amended in section 1 by deleting the definition of "Clerk" and substituting it with the following—

""Clerk" means the Clerk of the House of Assembly or persons appointed on the express authority of the Clerk to perform specific functions to facilitate the work of the Assembly;".

Citation

4. This Act may be cited as the House of Assembly (Powers and Privileges) (Amendment) Act, 2021.

OBJECTS AND REASONS

(The Objects and Reasons do not form part of this Act)

The Bill for the House of Assembly (Powers and Privileges) (Amendment) Act, 2021 amends the House of Assembly Powers and Privileges Act, R.S.A. c. H15 and consists of 4 clauses. As a result of the repeal and replacement of the Legislative Assembly (Procedure) Rules, 1976, for consistency purposes, the definitions of "clerk" and "stranger" in the House of Assembly Powers and Privileges Act, R.S.A. c. H15 also had to be changed.
