



DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR THE DETERMINATION OF ANGUILLIAN STATUS BY VIRTUE OF YOUR GREAT-GRANDPARENT(S) BEING BORN IN ANGUILLA

- 1) Two (2) passport size photographs
- 2) Birth Certificate—Applicant
- 3) Birth Certificate—Mother or Father
- 4) Birth Certificate—Grandmother or Grandfather and Great-Grandparent
- 5) Marriage Certificate—Applicant (showing change of maiden name ,if applicable)
- 6) Divorce Certificate (if applicable)
- 7) Police Certificate of Character
- 8) A Sworn Affidavit must be made before a Notary Public if there is a discrepancy in the spelling of a name, missing name or any other inconsistencies. **NB: Applicant cannot do an Affidavit for himself/herself.**
- 9) Two (2) Notarized reference letters from Anguillians (non-relatives) who have known the applicant residing in Anguilla for **No less than five (5) years.**
- 10) You must provide a written account explaining periods of overstay in Anguilla. Your application will **NOT** be processed until all outstanding periods overstayed are paid in full.
- 11) A receipt for the sum of Two hundred dollars (EC\$200.00 non-refundable) to be paid at the Inland Revenue Department evidencing payment of the processing fee.
- 12) Applicant must show proof of FIVE (5) years legal residence on Anguilla, such as, Passports, Copies of Passport, Work Permits, School Letters, Job Letters

N.B: Original and photocopies of the relevant documents, with English translation where applicable, must be submitted
