Whereas Section 13(2)a and 13(2)d (i) of the Public Procurement and Contract Administration (Amendment) Act outlines the powers of the Board in relation to the use of standard documents and;

Whereas the Chief Procurement Officer has already indicated her disagreement with the revised Request for Proposals and;

Whereas the Chief Procurement Officer has the right to express her disagreement in any forum that she may so desire and;

Whereas the Procurement Board is prepared to be accountable for, and is comfortable with its decision in the procurement at hand, especially in comparison to other actions in the procurement process and;

Whereas clarifications as specified in the Request for Proposals before the date for the submission of proposals are nothing new in the procurement process;

Be It Resolved the Request for Proposals Document as reviewed and modified using input from the Procurement Committee, and the Procurement Board be the document used in the procurement for solid waste management and disposal services.
